Can a Timor-Leste solar power plant be financed?

The tender, which was announced in February this year by state utility Eletricidade de Timor-Leste, is seeking an investor that can design, finance, operate and maintain a 72-85 MW solar power plant and a 36-43 MW battery energy project under long-term purchase agreements with the state grid in the capital city of Manatuto, the sources said.

Can Timor-Leste generate solar energy?

What is Timor-Leste's energy policy?

However, the most of its national budget for the electric power sector are spent on fuel import and electricity charges, so it is difficult to realize its policy.

What does a solar technician do in Timor-Leste?

Technicians in Timor-Leste have experience in small-scale,off-grid solar energy systems. Commercial or industrial scale installations are more complex and appropriate technical capacity is scarce.

How long does a solar system last in Timor-Leste?

High electricity costs and readily available solar radiation mean that the average payback period for a rooftop photovoltaic (PV) solar energy system in Timor-Leste is only 1.5 to 3 years instead of the global average of 6-10 years. Transitioning to solar can also help the country meet environmental commitments.
