Is it legal to fit a washing machine in a bathroom?

Is it legal to fit a washing machine in the bathroom? It's not strictly illegal to have a washing machine in a bathroom but, due to building regulations in the UK, you do need to consider how and where it's installed. Plug sockets are typically not fitted in bathrooms in the UK, with the exception of shaver sockets.

The main criteria is that a person in the bath or shower (and presumably even on the toilet) should NOT be able to touch the washing machine.
