

# Can the photovoltaic panels be cancelled if they are not installed as scheduled

Can I cancel a solar panel contract?

Common reasons for canceling a solar panel contract include: Moving into a new home where the solar panel agreement cannot be transferred. Financial difficulties make it challenging to keep up with payments. The best approach usually involves negotiation. You can contact the solar company to discuss the terms under which you can exit the contract.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
