Gunkul Chiba Solar PV Park is a ground-mounted solar project which is spread over an area of 47 hectares. The project generates 45,000MWh electricity and supplies enough clean energy to power 10,000 households, offsetting 20,000t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO2) a year. Development status The project got commissioned in April 2019.

Kyocera has announced that its latest floating solar (FPV) power plant on the Yamakura Dam reservoir in Chiba Prefecture, Japan is operational, making the 13.7MW FPV plant the largest in Japan.

The solar plant was built over the surface of the reservoir, which is managed by the waterworks bureau of Chiba Prefecture for its industrial use. With a 180,000m² surface area, 50,904 270W Kyocera solar modules were installed to generate an estimated 16,170MWh a year, which is enough to power nearly 5,000 households.
