Can I remove a Jinko Solar module?

Do not remove any part installed by Jinko Solar or disassemble the module. All instructions should be read and understood before attempting to install, wire, operate, and maintain the module. Do not lift up PV modules using the attached cables or the junction box. All PV systems must be grounded to earth.

What should you not do with a Jinko Solar module?

Do not touch live terminals with bare hands. Use insulated tools for electrical connections. Do not remove any part installed by Jinko Solar or disassemble the module. operate and maintain the module. Please don't lift up PV modules using the attached cables or the junction box. All PV systems must be earthed.

Operation in permanent shading conditions is not recommended. Do not install the PV module near open flame or flammable materials. JinkoSolar PV modules have passed the IEC 61701 salt spray corrosion test. The PV modules can be installed at a distance of 50m away from the seashore.

Do Jinko Solar PV modules pass the salt spray corrosion test?

JinkoSolar PV modules have passed the IEC 61701 salt spray corrosion test. The PV modules can be installed at a distance of 50m away from the seashore. In the case when the modules are installed within 50m to 500m distance from the seashore, the connectors shall be protected, i.e., adding dust plugs.
