Do solar panels come with a warranty?

Solar panels usually come with two types of warranties: The product warranty covers defects in the solar panel itself and typically covers around 20-25 years, although some manufacturers offer longer warranties up to 30 years or beyond.

What is a performance warranty on a solar panel?

A performance warranty guarantees a maximum level of degradation- typically between .25% and .75% - per year so that in 25 years the panel will still have 80-90% of the power output it did in its first year. Performance warranties are important for sizing solar systems to maintain 100% offset for 25 years.

How long do solar panels last?

Workmanship and materials warranty of one or two years. Batteries (non-grid systems / hybrids) roughly 5-15 years. Inverter (s) warranty of between 5-10 years. There are many factors that must be borne in mind when considering warranties for you solar panel system.
