The United States currently claims sixteen insular areas as territories. These include American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, and the United States Minor Outlying Islands.

Faced with the perception that Jarvis, and other unoccupied territorial islands in the Pacific, may not be recognized as US territory, the federal government took unusual action, establishing a program in 1935, known as the American Equatorial Islands Colonization Project.
